- Fast and error free. Solid framework.



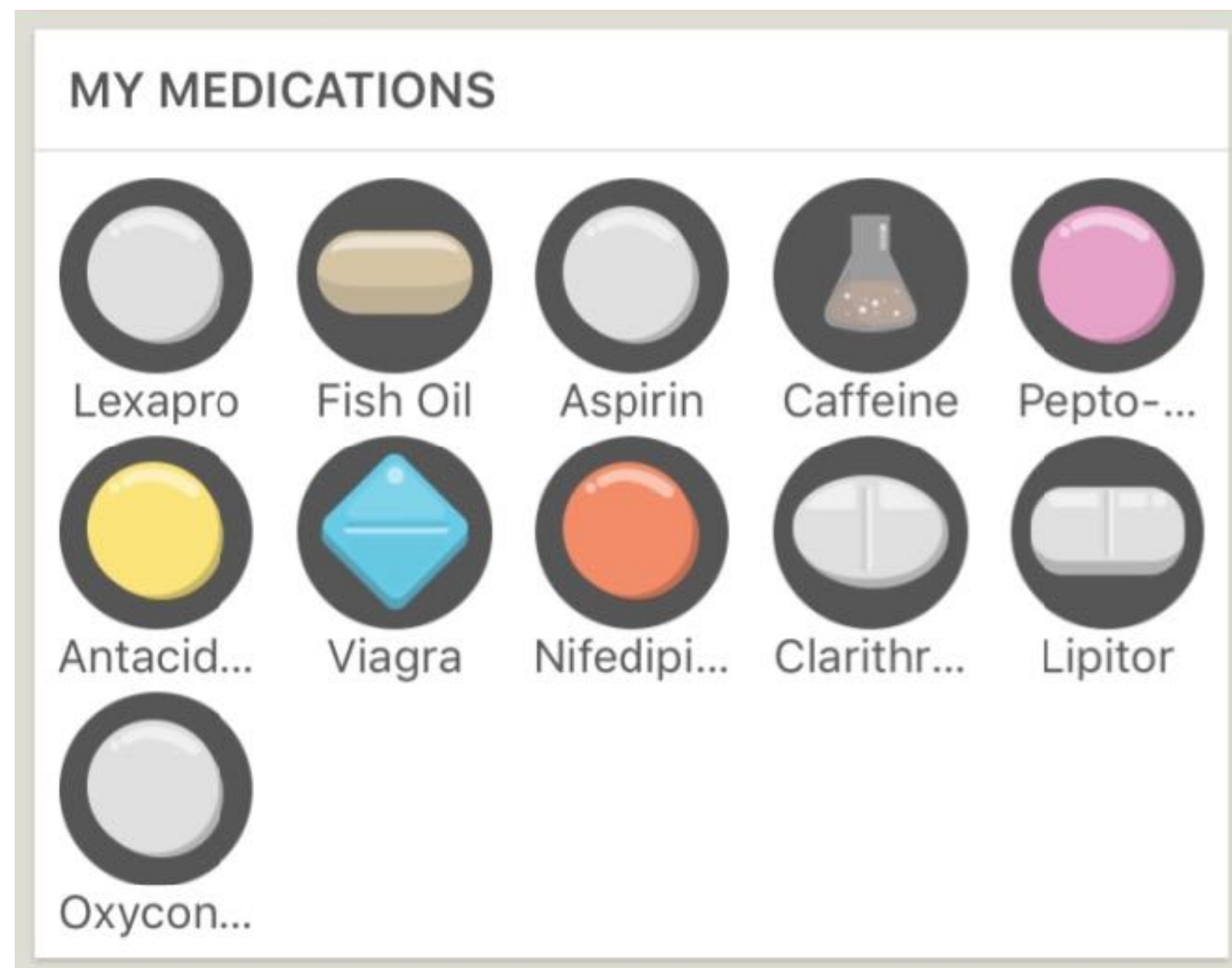
